Re: Response to the submission dated June 4, 2018

Thank you for your correspondence dated June 4, 2018. The Canadian Transportation Agency (Agency) has reviewed your correspondence and does not find that a change in the discussion paper posted on the Agency's consultation website is required.

The discussion paper offers contextual information on the Convention for the Unification of certain Rules for International Carriage by Air (Montreal Convention) for reference purposes. While the Montreal Convention provides recourse for damages, the new regulations would provide for minimum compensation in certain cases.

Rest assured that, in the development of the regulations on air passenger protection, the Agency will take into account the Montreal Convention, where applicable.

We will consider your letter dated June 4, 2018 as forming part of the consultations.
